Treasurer's Report:

Dance Report:

A total of 124 tickets were sold for a total of \$2270.00, liquor sales totaled \$1800.00 and the Silent Auction totaled \$2479.00. Total income was \$691.67, total expenses were \$2775.71 for a profit of \$4015.96, plus a \$60.00 donation from Barnhartvale resident Delbert Alder. Maintenance:

A microwave was donated by the Armstrong family. It needs to be installed. A new cover for the fluorescent light fixture is needed. The Exit lights still need to be replaced. Then toilet seat in the ladies' washroom is extremely loose and needs to be fixed.

Newsletter:

The next newsletter goes out in August, if there are any items that need to be in the newsletter, contact Tami.

Publicity:

Posters and newsletters are out for the Family Dance. They were up for the Garage Sale as well. A sandwich board went missing from the store. Tami will check with them to see if they moved it. A discussion took place about the benefit of having signage outside of the Hall for upcoming events. All agreed it would be beneficial.

New Business/Old Business:

1. Garage Sale expenses totaled \$212.50. We made \$ 190.50 for a loss of \$22.00. It was agreed by all that this was the last year for the Garage Sale concession as no profit has been made the last two years.
2. The Family Dance is Sept. 25, 2010. Tickets will be in store around the 7th of September. Kids 5 and under are free, over 5 and up will be \$5.00. Drink tokens will remain \$4.00 each by unanimous vote.
3. The Hardiplank going up on the Hall could be a possible insurance break due to the fact that it is fireproof. Karen H. will talk to Rick Frost from the insurance company to discuss.
4. Other possible improvements to the Hall that were discussed included putting up eaves troughs around the building to prevent rot, and a cement barricade in front of the Hall to prevent anyone from accidentally driving into the Hall. Michelle's brother in law is looking into a new furnace. He can purchase it at cost and provide free labor.
5. Teresa presented the report for the new roof. Expenses were \$6085.54 for labor and \$4330.86 for supplies. Leftover materials were returned for a refund of \$457.48, making the total cost \$9958.92.
6. The Summer Social will take place on July 3rd, 2010 at Teresa's house. Show up any time after 5:00 p.m., all you need to bring is an appetizer, salad or desert and what you are going to barbecue.
