Maintenance:

One of the fluorescent light fixtures needs to have the cover put back into place. Andy will be buying light bulbs to fix the remaining Exit light by the side door.

New Business/Old Business:

1. Silent Auction/Dance, May 29th, 2010- Cheryl from the Coffee House has given us checked tablecloths and lent us candle holders for decorating. Set up will be 10:00am that morning. - Auction portion will be open for bids as soon as the doors open. Bidding will close approximately 10:45, and announced at 11:00 pm. There will be a separate table for the auction items as well as additional tables for a Twoonie Toss, etc. Donations are still greatly needed for the auction. Places still not hit: Tumbleweeds Pub, Petro Canada, Pineridge Golf Course, Roots to Shoots Nursery and Happy Valley Foods. If you get a donation from these places, please try to obtain business cards, the item donated and the value of the donation so Don T. can draw up a list of sponsors to place on each table. 2. Don T. also got an approximate estimate to reside the front and sides of the Hall in Hardiplank and the back of the Hall in a different option for cost purposes. The rough estimate is \$5000-\$6000. This will be our aim for the Auction/Dance.
 3. Michelle has spoken with the SPCA, and their Craft Fair was also scheduled for the 7th of November. Our Craft Fair was rescheduled for November 14th, 2010. It was also agreed that the price of each table would increase from \$20.00 to \$25.00.
 4. Lavon has printed the new membership cards. Amanda will fill them out and pass them out at the next meeting.
 5. It was agreed that we will donate another free rental to the RLC Silent Auction. Diana Major will draw up the certificate, which will include costs for licensing and damage deposit.
 6. The question was raised what our options would be in cases where damage was done but the cost was over \$150.00 (damage deposit). What could we do to cover those costs, and can we think of any way to work it into the rental agreement. The topic was tabled for another time.
